SOW (Student Of the Word): A Bible Centered K-12th Curriculum; the goal is to know God; the method is discipleship, and the Bible is the main text.

Since our last of five children graduated in 2010, we now have the time to mentor SOW families and update the SOW Curriculum. Our plans are to develop and update student skill level worksheets with student samples, instructional DVDs, TE/SE lessons with charts, and a resource list for skill levels ... K-5th, 6th-12th, and Advanced.

These K-5th, 6th-12th, and Advanced skill level worksheets with samples are PDF files (ebooks) delivered by secure email. Each set contains 40-60 master worksheets and its coordinating sample worksheets. They are designed to make implementing the SOW Curriculum easier for the student and the teacher/parent. The skill level worksheets are to be used according to each student's grade or skill level. The student's grade or skill level is the student's instructional level (The student is physically, mentally, emotionally, and academically ready to learn and be taught by repeating concepts and skills for mastery.). If you know your student's grade level, simply use the worksheets in that grade level for every subject. If you do not know your student's grade level, you must determine the student's grade or skill level for each subject. We encourage you to use the SOW recommended Brigance Diagnostic Test to find each student's grade or skill (instructional) level. Since students can cross grade or skill levels, any of these two sets of worksheets can be used by any one student in any subject. For example, a nine year old or third grader can use the K-5th writing worksheet and the 6th-12th spelling worksheet.

These new beta (test version) SOW skill level worksheets are being created and updated, continuously, as we receive feedback from SOW users. Those, who purchase any new SOW beta material and give us feedback, will receive free updates, as available, and a discount when finally published. Please rate each worksheet from 1-5 on appearance, implementation, thoroughness, content, explanation, etc., and send us your comments, ideas, corrections, and suggestions concerning these worksheets.

How to use the SOW K-5th Skill Level Worksheets:

K-5th students are considered instructional students requiring teacher instruction; therefore, the teacher will follow a weekly schedule and a specific scope and sequence and use lessons with charts in the teacher edition. The teacher edition also includes a recommended resource to be used with each subject. The students will use specific skill level worksheets for each subject to complete a lesson in every subject.

Important: Before using the SOW skill level worksheets, you should make a CD of these worksheets to save for back up use.

Suggestions for using these K-5th skill level worksheets...

- 1. Copy and put all the skill level worksheets in binders for each of your K-5th students to follow each day; students put answers in a regular lined notebook, not on worksheets. (Use this option, if you are on a tight budget or do not have easy access to a copy machine.)**

AND/OR

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- 2. Copy specific worksheets as needed each week, place them in a pocket folder for each of your K-5th students to use and complete during the week; when lessons are finished each week, store completed worksheets in a large binder (add pictures to make a SOW scrapbook/yearbook at the end of each year for display).**

NOTE: Master and sample skill level worksheets are in separate PDF files. All samples correlate with a master worksheet and with a specific lesson. The volume, lesson number, and Bible reference will be noted at the top of each sample worksheet.

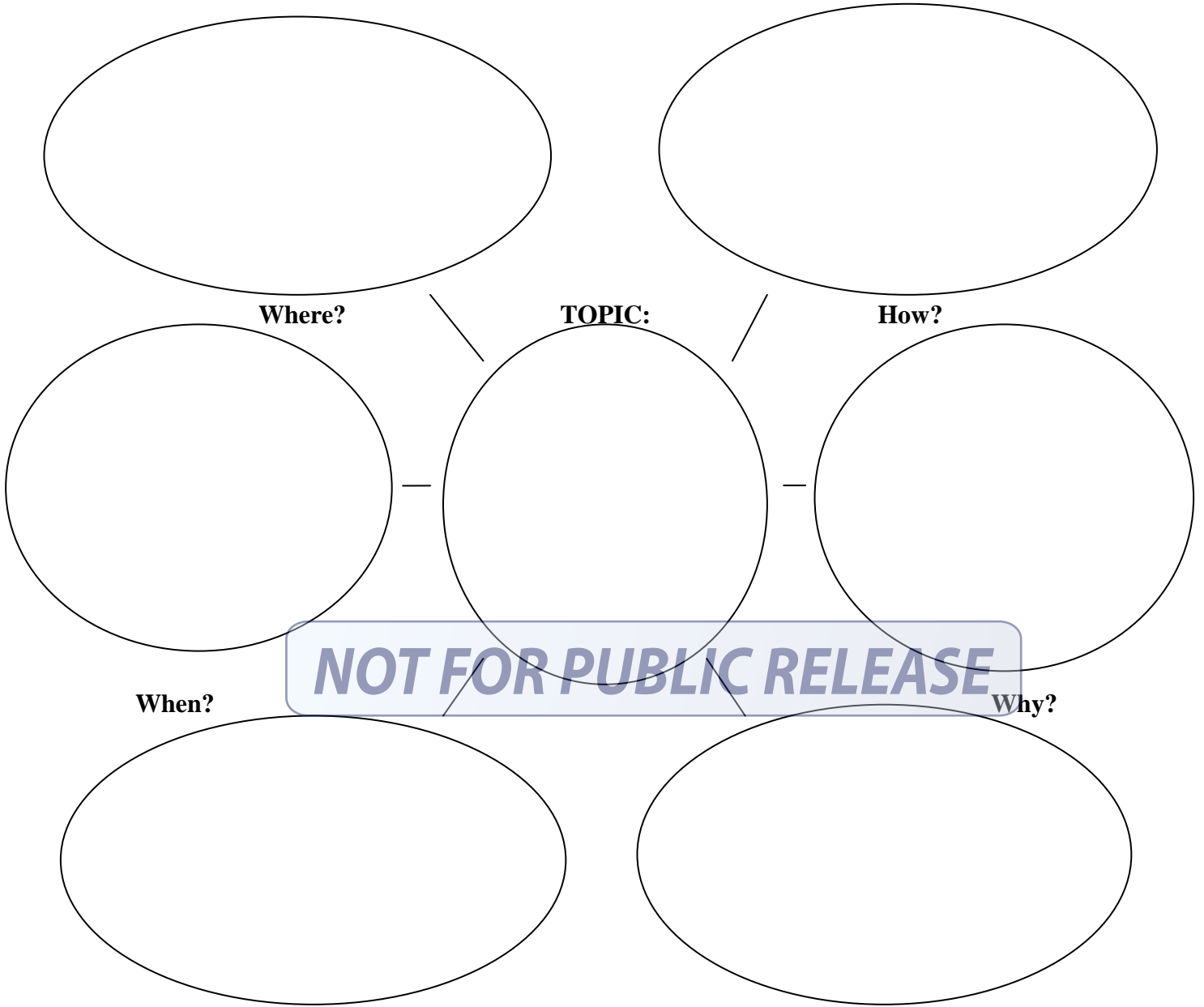
