## BRING

Each family should bring food for every meal that's easy to fix, utensils, snacks & desserts, ice chest of drinks and ice, folding table and chairs, mosquito spray, suntan lotion, Bible, tent, pop-up, or other, sleeping bags & pillows, towels, extra change of clothes & shoes, extra blankets, a jacket, musical instruments for worship, bikes, axe for chopping firewood (dead branches and logs only), matches, charcoal for grill, flashlights &/or lanterns, football, kickball, & basketball, & binoculars. For infants bring playpen & back carrier.
